

# New Course!

## Announcing a new course for WINTER 2007: **EASL 0635 - English for Foreign Trained Professionals**

**When?** Saturday morning + 1 evening + online time (6 credits)

**Where?** NW campus

**Who is the course for?** People who have professional certification from another country and are unable to work in that profession here in Canada for a variety of reasons, one of which is probably language.



**What is the course about?**

1. developing oral communication skills for the professional workplace (ex. in social situations at work; on the telephone; participating in meetings; giving professional presentations;
2. enhancing business writing skills (ex. writing emails, reports, memos; compiling an ePortfolio);
3. developing strategies for speaking clearly, listening effectively, and understanding idiomatic language in a professional setting.

**How long will the class run?** Jan. 8th, 2007 - April 11, 2007

**How much is the course?** Regular fees for a six-credit course.

**How do I register?** Students must first complete an assessment and interview. Sign up for these at the EASL department office, room 4200 at NW campus.
